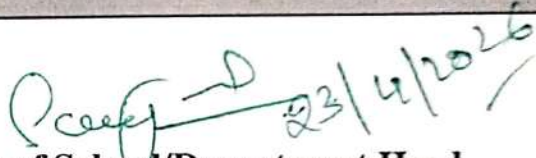
Dr. Anita Rai, Principal, addressed the gathering and highlighted the humanitarian aspect of blood donation.
