Venue: Room No. 101, Seminar Hall

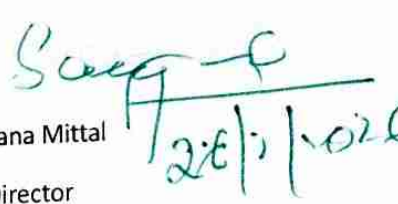
